## **PRESS RELEASE**

The Food and Drugs Board (FDB) in collaboration with the Bureau of National Investigation (BNI) wish to inform the general public that it is investigating an unauthorized re-labelling of a food product; ***Hallelujah Non Alcoholic Sparkling Wine*** (Apple, White Grape and Red Grape Flavours).

The products, which are suspected to have expired, were being re-labelled with new expiry date of **27/02/2010**.

The importer, Budget Cash and Carry has since been directed to recall the implicated products from trade for supervised destruction since FDB cannot guarantee their safety and quality for human consumption.

The general public, wholesalers and retailers are being cautioned against the patronage of the affected products with the said expiry date (**27/02/2010**). Any one who has the implicated products in his or her possession is also advised to return them to the importer or inform the Food and Drugs Board on **0244337243/0244337235/0244-337251**.

The Food and Drugs Board (FDB) however wishes to assure the general public that appropriate measures are in place to ensure the total recall of the Hallelujah Non Alcoholic Sparkling Wine with the indicated expiry date; 27/02/2010, and furthermore, of its commitment to safeguard public health and safety.
